The ArTeC master's is a transdisciplinary master's program between humanities, arts, and digital technology. Its objective is to train artists-researchers who possess both in-depth knowledge of the theoretical issues involved in "research-creation" and a high-level artistic practice.

## 3 core principles



### Transdisciplinarity


It offers a wide variety of teaching that combines theoretical explorations and practice. Co-accredited by Paris 8 and Paris Nanterre universities, it offers students access to around 30 master's courses that complete the common core of the ArTeC master's program.

### Study abroad

In the third semester, each student spends a semester of study abroad. As part of this program, students benefit from a grant of €500 per month, which can be combined with any other grant or funding. There's a wide range of destinations to choose from the international relations services of the two universities Paris 8 and Paris Nanterre.

### Experimentation

Throughout the two-year master's program, students pursue research that culminates in an experimental personal project, which may take the form of: performance, film, cultural mediation practice, exhibition, creative writing, digital creation, or other formats. These projects are supported within a cultural institution, as part of an event that is open to the public.



The professional opportunities arising from the ArTeC master's degree are numerous, depending on the specialization chosen by each student: scientific and cultural mediation, cultural and artistic communication, exhibition curation, digital engineering, arts teaching, independent design and creation, management of cultural projects, pursuit of doctoral studies, etc.
